Below you will find a summary of key developments and projects that the Government of Nunavut (GN) worked on in 2016.

### Funds for the Seal Industry

In January, the GN, in partnership with the federal government, announced a \$150,000 investment in support for Canada's Indigenous seal industry.

### Suicide Prevention Action Plan

In March, the GN released *Resiliency Within: A One Year Suicide Prevention Plan* for Nunavut. Our plan outlines a number of commitments for public and community engagement, as well as training, programs, and support for Nunavummiut.

### Grays Bay Road & Port Project

In July we signed an agreement with the Kitikmeot Inuit Association to formalize cooperation as co-proponents of the Grays Bay Road and Port Project.

### Infrastructure Funding

Together with the federal government, we reached an agreement to invest \$68 million in infrastructure funding for Nunavut.

### Investments in the Nunavut Arctic College

In November, the GN and the Government of Canada announced a \$29.54 million investment in the Nunavut Arctic College, to help young Nunavummiut access the education and training they need for future success.
