## Rartnership Declaration

Constitutionally protected rights under the Nunavut Agreement;

Whereas Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated (NTI) is the primary Inuit organization with the mandate to advocate for and speak on behalf of Nunavut Inuit with respect to their indigenous

and treaty rights and benefits under the *Nunavut Agreement*;

whereas the Government of Nunavut (GN), in exercising its jurisdiction as a democratic and responsible public government must serve the needs and priorities of all citizens of Nunavut, in a fair and equitable manner;

whereas NTI and the GN commit to a collaborative partnership based on mutual respect, integrity and accountability;

Whereas the creation of the Nunavut
Partnership Committee, and the development of its joint terms of reference, is an important step toward advancing shared interests for Nunavummiut;

recognizing full and fair implementation of the obligations and objectives of the Nunavut Agreement as foundational for creating prosperity among Nunavut Inuit which benefits all Nunavummiut;

*recognizing* this partnership allows for identification of broad principles and priorities, in addition to practical commitments in relation to leadership, oversight, and administration that will focus and enhance working relationships and outcomes;

now, therefore, Nunavut Tunngavik

Incorporated and the Government of Nunavut have, in this Declaration, achieved consensus regarding the creation of the Nunavut Partnership Committee to collaboratively identify and take action on shared priorities and monitor progress going forward.
