Dear Mr. Savikataaq,

Thank you for your letter outlining Nunavut's key priorities for this federal election. As the Leader of the Green Party of Canada, I am deeply committed to ensuring that every Nunavummiut's needs are met, and that every person has the necessary supports to live with dignity.

I see significant alignment between the priorities you outlined, and what the Green Party of Canada is proposing in our election platform. Investing in permanent housing solutions for people in inadequate living conditions, continuing to invest in infrastructure to close the infrastructure gap and increase access to services, and creating a more robust health care system, are cornerstone policy areas in our 2021 platform.

The Green Party of Canada is calling for a reinvestment in affordable, non-profit, co-operative and supportive housing to address the housing and homelessness crises; investments in infrastructure, broadband, and expanded transit services to revitalize communities; and collaboration with provincial/territorial governments to strengthen our health care system and provide better and more accessible mental health services to meet the increased demand that the pandemic only exacerbated.
